
# WELCOME to the ART STUDIO






What I expect in the Art studio






- I have asked for students to have their own supplies this year to keep your children safe and minimize cross contamination.

- Come to class with a positive attitude!








Using knowledge of Elements of art and the functions of Principles of design





Choosing and evaluating a range of subject matter, symbols, and ideas [content]









All major projects will follow the design thinking process which will help students organize and collaborate in groups and cross curricular work



What we need to create our Art








#### Required:


