LEARN A SPORT: BASKETBALL

Basketball is a sport where 2 teams of 5 have to try to put the ball into a 10-foot-high hoop. There are 2 hoops on the rectangular shaped court, one on each of the shorter ends. Each team is assigned which hoop to score on. You get 2 points per basket, and beyond a round line, about 24 feet away professionally, you score 3 points for each made basket. When you have the ball, you cannot walk with the ball, you must bounce the ball every step, also known as dribbling. When you are on offense (the team with the ball), the other team will try to stop you from scoring, or defending. If you score, the other team gets the ball, but if you don't, it is a loose ball (when neither team has possession of the ball), and whatever team gets the ball, or rebound, gets the ball. The team with the most points at the end of regulation wins the game.
