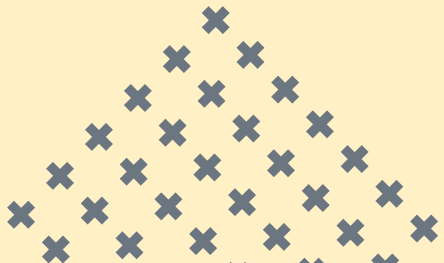
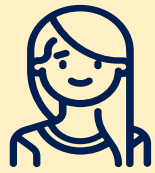




WELCOME to the **ART STUDIO**

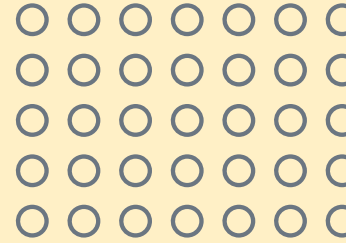
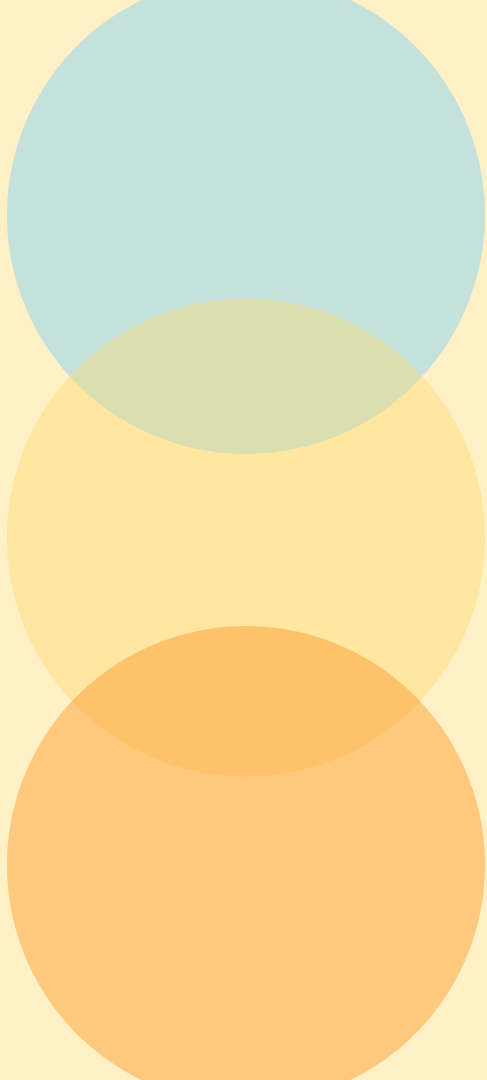

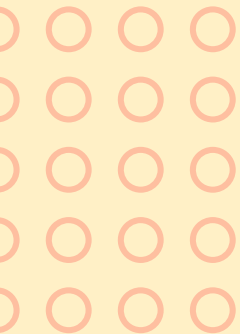
What I expect in the Art
studio



When we are in the classroom I would like each student to bring their sketchbook and a pencil case with the supplies from our supply list.

- I have asked for students to have their own supplies this year to keep your children safe and minimize cross contamination.
- Students will be spaced 6 ft apart in the Art room whenever possible and must wear masks.
- Students will be responsible for cleaning up and putting away their own supplies at the end of class
- Mrs. Bello will sanitize the tables between classes
- Mrs. Bello will hand out and collect any ongoing classwork that isn't in the sketchbook





Expectations in the Studio

- Respect Ms. Bello and peers
- Use your inside voice during class
- Listen to all directions, and ask questions during demonstrations

- Come to class with a positive attitude!

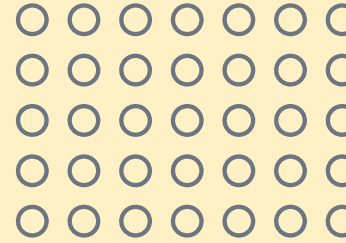
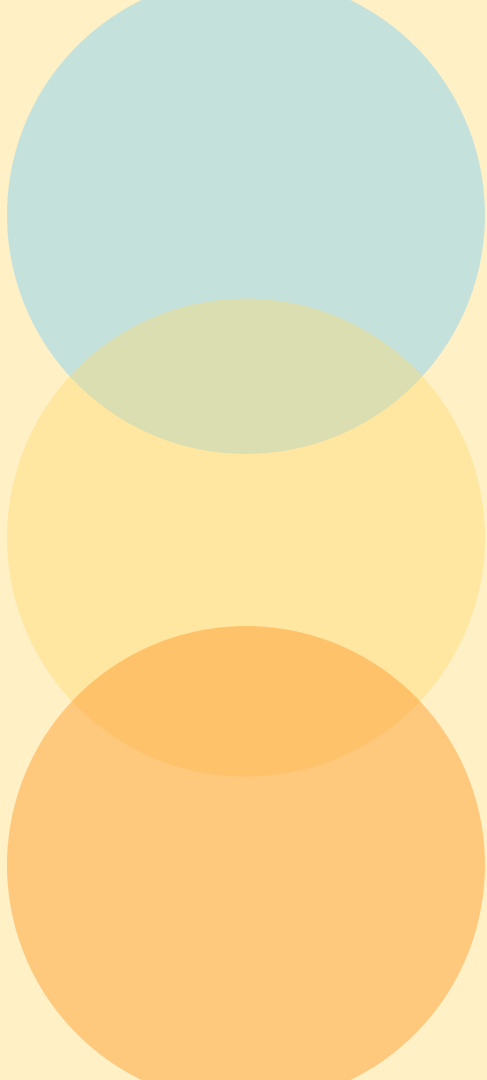




Google Classroom

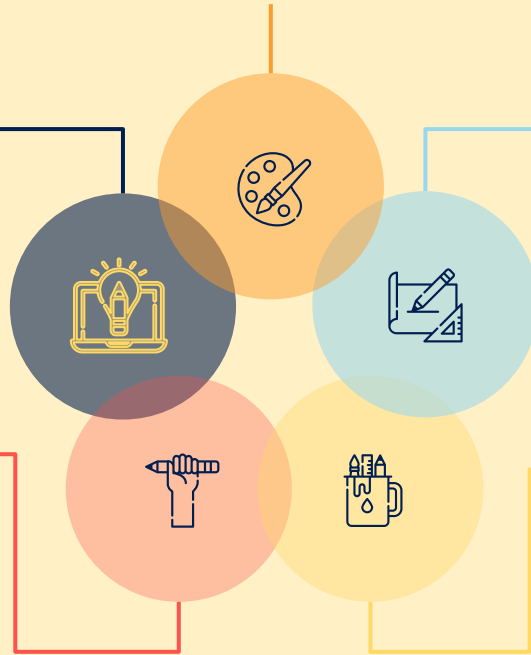

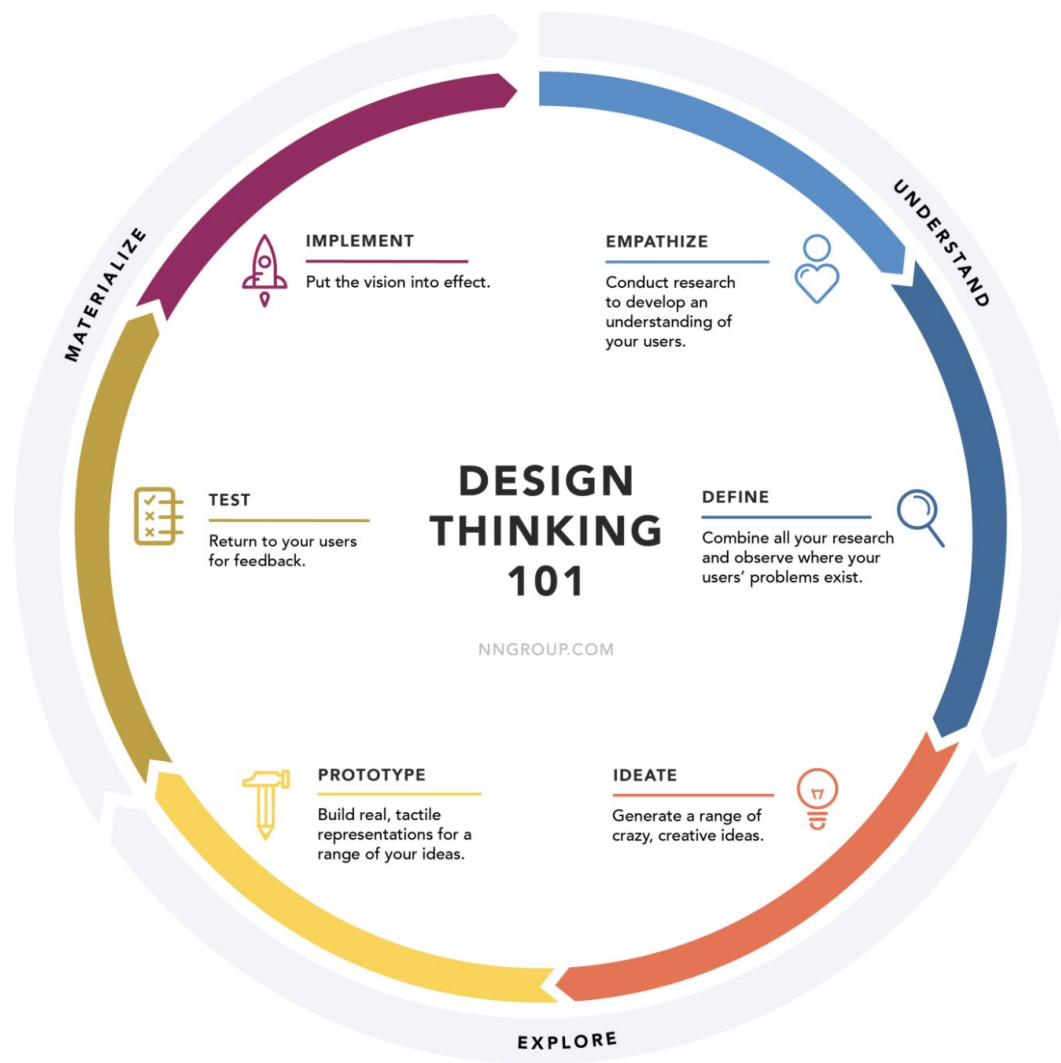

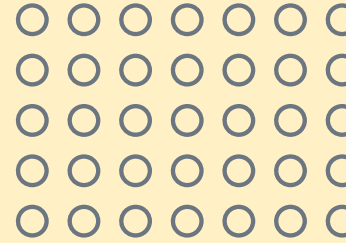

All major projects will follow the design thinking process which will help students organize and collaborate in groups and cross curricular work

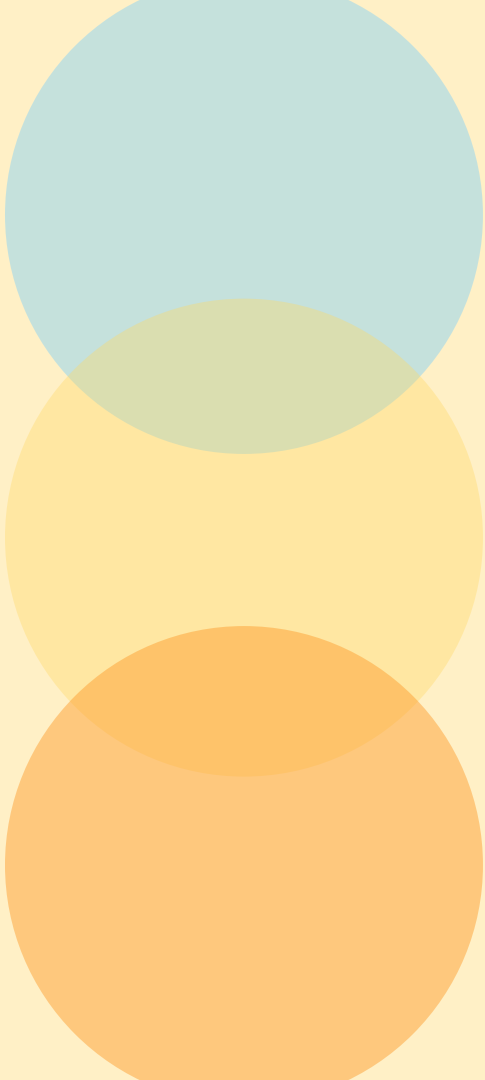


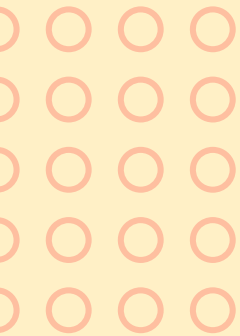

Required:

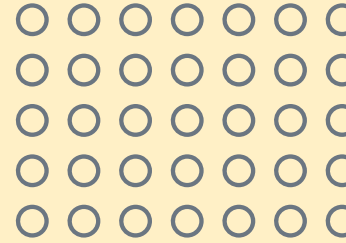
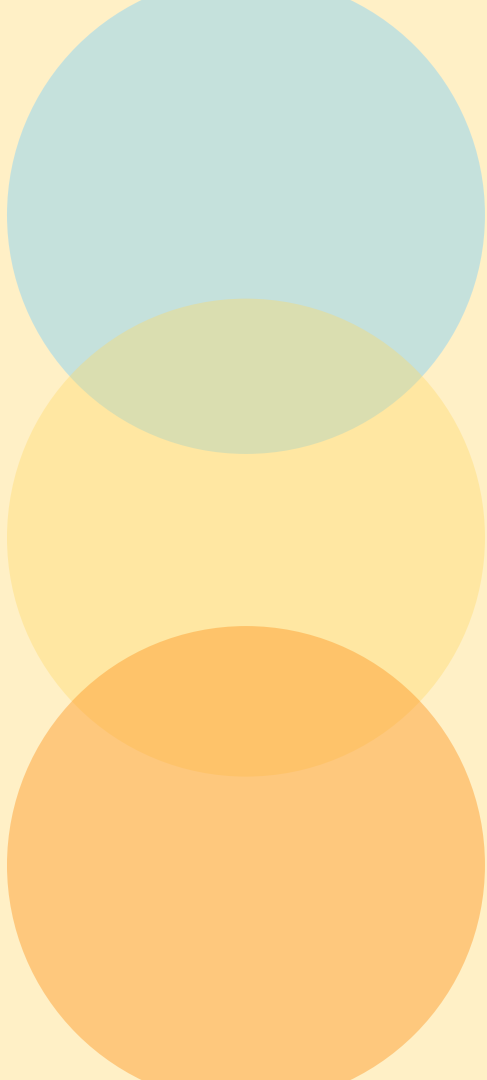
- 1 8x10 sketchbook
